Concept Note

June 2021 marks the 10th anniversary of the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights (UNGPs) and their unanimous endorsement by the UN Human Rights Council (HRC). The last 10 years of business and human rights have been shaped significantly by the UNGPs, which provide the globally agreed standard and baseline for what businesses and Governments need to do to embed respect for human rights in a business context. The anniversary provides a key opportunity to recommit and share ambitions for increasing the pace of UNGPs implementation over the next decade.

Following a stock-taking exercise and discussions towards the development of a roadmap for the next decade by the [UN Working Group on Business and Human Rights](#), the [International Chamber of Commerce](#) (ICC) and the [United Nations Global Compact](#) welcome you to join a high-level conversation on key business opportunities to engage in the process and the value of business engagement. On this occasion, we re-affirm our commitment to meeting our responsibility to respect human rights under Pillar II of the UNGPs, to improve implementation of the UNGPs over the next 10 years, and to engage in multistakeholder discussions on the roadmap that will be developed by the UN Working Group on Business and Human Rights.
