Southcoast Health Group looked for new solutions when replacing the previous patient fluid waste collection and disposal system. With many of the surgical operations generating low/medium volume of surgical fluids, using a high-volume closed system for collecting and flushing medical waste fluid generated more costs and over-use and/or using a re-usable canister cleaning system was timely and required bulky chemicals to store, rather than using a closed system with disposable liners.

Serres Nemo, used together with Serres suction bags, provides a safe and cost-efficient combination for surgical fluid waste management in hospitals.

Serres Nemo is optimized for low to medium fluid volume surgical cases, allowing staff to empty surgical fluid

waste on-site directly into the sewer without ever opening a lid of the suction liner, minimizing the unwanted spills or exposure. Serres Nemo also reduces the amount of waste by approximately 90%, once the fluids are disposed to sewer, only the empty liner needs incineration or disposing.
